# ***WELCOME TO YOUR PROGRAM RESOURCE CENTER!***

## **What IS the Program Resource Center?**

It's a small Girl Scout "library" (or media center) where Girl Scout adults can check out:

- Program activity kits ("Treasure Boxes") and modules.
- Videotapes and DVDs
- Audiotapes and CDs
- Games
- Books
- Posters

We have materials to help you with Try-Its, badges, Interest Projects (IPAs) and other awards, troop meeting activities and camp. Most materials can be checked out for up to **3 weeks**.



## **Hours**

The Program Resource Center is open for your use whenever the Volunteer Service Center and Badge and Sash are open. Please call 706-226-1435 to confirm times.

## **How to Checkout, Renew, and Return Materials:**

Materials may be checked out any time the Resource Center is open, but you may also **reserve** materials up to six weeks in

advance. Call 706-226-1435 for details.

When you check out materials, you will be asked to fill out a checkout form and may be asked to leave a *fully refundable security DEPOSIT*. The amount of the deposit is the replacement cost for all the materials you are checking out. You may leave a troop or personal check, or a credit card number. Your deposit will not be processed unless the materials are lost or damaged beyond repair. **NOTE:** Your materials are considered "lost" if they have not been returned within one month of the due date!

When you check out a Treasure Box (activity kit) please allow time to go through the box's contents with a staff person, to be sure everything is there.

Materials may be renewed **one time**, usually for two weeks. You may renew materials in person, by phone, or by e-mail.

## **Returns:**

Materials are due back the last day of the reservation – check the date due sticker on your materials! If you or your troop need more time with the materials, please call to see if they can be renewed (see above.) When returning Treasure Boxes, please allow time to go through the contents with a staff person. You will not be charged for

items that are used up, worn out, or have minor damage. The check-in helps the Resource Center be sure everything is ready for the next check out.

Running late? Can't get to the Service Center? You may return your materials by mail, UPS, or other shipper. Please package items securely and safely; you will be charged if items are damaged because of poor packaging.

### \$ Late Fees

There is a "grace period" of **three business days** after the date that materials are due. Late fees of **20¢ per item, per business day** will be charged for any items returned after that time. *For overdue items returned by mail or shipper, fines are assessed for the time after the "grace period" through the postmarked date on the returned items.*



**PLEASE RETURN MATERIALS CLEAN AND DRY! We reserve the right to NOT accept wet and dirty materials (including containers) and to hold your deposit until materials are returned in good condition. *Late fees may be applied.***

### ***Direct Delivery from The Atlanta Resource Center is Available (Credit Card Required)***

To have **books, videos, or audiotapes** (*sorry, we can't ship games or Treasure Boxes*) mailed or shipped to your home or business, follow these easy steps:

1. Call the Program Resource Center in Atlanta (404-527-7672 **or** toll-free at 800-771-4046 ext. 7672) to request the items you want to borrow (maximum of four.) *Please call at least two weeks before you need your materials.*
2. The Resource Center Coordinator will take your name, address, phone number, troop number, service unit name, and **credit card information** (VISA, MasterCard or American Express.) The mailing/shipping cost will be billed to your credit card. The deposit fee will not be billed. Materials will be sent the next business day.
3. Materials must be returned on time to the Atlanta Resource Center; you may mail/ship them or return them in person to the Atlanta Volunteer Service Center. Late fees apply!

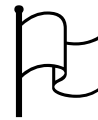

**TALKING WITH TJ: TEAMWORK" – for grades 2-4; 1993:** Six 45-minute sessions\* to improve teamwork skills of planning, cooperating, appreciating differences, and working together in more caring and cooperative ways. Includes video, leader's guide, posters and worksheets for 15 girls. \* May be reserved for up to 6 weeks. Also great for sleepovers and lock-ins.

**TAP DANCING FOR BEGINNERS – grades 3 and up – 30 minutes –** Learn the basics from legendary tap dance instructor and choreographer Henry Le Tang. PROGRAM LINK: Dance badge; Invitation to the Dance IPA.

Governor, Children and Youth Coordinating Council; addressed to both girls and boys; makes the case that teens have choices to make about sexual activity; blunt, first-hand accounts tell of regrets and challenges faced by teen parents, the effects on teens' families; explains current Georgia laws about aid to teen mothers and children, child support, statutory rape laws; promotes the choice for sexual abstinence in favor of setting and reaching life goals. *USE SENSITIVE ISSUES PERMISSION SLIP.*

**UNFORGETTABLE PEN PAL** - Gold Star Media, 1989 – 28 minutes – *for grades 3-5* - animated video helps kids learn about the negative effects of prejudice and discrimination, and will teach them the importance of forming their opinions about others intelligently. PROGRAM LINKS: Understanding Disabilities council patch; Celebrating People badge; It's Important to Me badge.

**WE CAN WORK IT OUT (CONFLICT RESOLUTION)** – Sunburst Communications, Inc., 2002 – *for grades K-2*; includes 11-minute video, worksheets, audiocassette, poster, audiocassette of songs, and game Teaches Daisy and Brownie Girl Scouts age-appropriate strategies for resolving conflicts. Shows how asking questions, listening, and thinking if ways to do things differently can provide satisfying solutions. PROGRAM LINK: Working It Out Try-It.

- 1921:** The Atlanta Girl Scout Council is chartered (2 counties)
- 1937:** The Floyd Co. Girl Scout Council is chartered.
- 1941:** The Whitfield Co. Girl Scout Council (2 counties) is chartered.
- 1945:** The Bartow Co. and Cobb Co. Girl Scout Councils are chartered.
- 1959:** The Atlanta Council changes its name to Greater Atlanta Council when five more counties join the original two.
- 1964:** All of the above councils, plus nine and a half unaffiliated counties, merge to form the Northwest Georgia Girl Scout Council.
- 1999:** The council name changes to Girl Scout Council of Northwest Georgia.
- 2008:** As part of the Girl Scouts of the USA Re-Alignment Project, the Girl Scout Councils of Northwest Georgia and Pine Valley, plus 5 counties from two other councils, merge to form the Girl Scouts of Greater Atlanta.
